Loons players report to Breezy Point in early September and will remain until the end of the season, which could extend into May. Players provide their own transportation and cell phones. The team asks its host families to provide a separate bedroom for the player(s). It must be furnished in a manner consistent with a college dormitory room (bed, desk, chair and internet availability). Players are expected to uphold all house rules, follow team curfew, keep a clean room and do their own laundry. Meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) are to be eaten with the host family unless other arrangements have been made for the day between the player and the family. Please be aware that many players have a large food requirement due to the physical demands of junior hockey. Housing families are compensated \$250 per player per month to assist with grocery expenses. Host families will enjoy the freedom of being able to temporarily leave town during the season providing arrangements have been made in advance with the Wings organization.
